Qualifications for the Academy Associate Category

In order to become an Academy Associate, those in allied professions must have a minimum of a bachelor's degree from a U.S. regionally accredited college or university or foreign equivalent. In addition, Associates must hold one of the certifications/licenses listed below:

- Certified Health Education Specialist (CHES)
- Certified Midwife (CM or CNM)
- Certified Professional—Food Safety (CP-FS)*
- Dental Hygienist (BS-DH or RDH* or LDH*)
- Dentist (DDS)
- Pharmacist (RPh or PharmD)
- Physical or Occupational Therapist (PT/OT)
- Physician (MD or DO)
- Physician Assistant (PA)
- Registered Environmental Health Specialist/Registered Sanitarian (REHS/RS)
- Registered Nurse (RN)*
- School Nutrition Specialist (SNS)*
- Speech-Language Pathologist (CCC-SLP)
- A degree in Culinary Arts from a U.S. regionally accredited college or university or U.S. culinary association*
- Certified Culinary Professional (certification from the American Culinary Foundation or the International Association of Culinary Professionals)*
- Certified Sports Medicine Practitioner (eg, certification from the American College of Sports Medicine)*
- Certified Dietary Manager (CDM), (certification from the Dietary Managers Association)*
