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#### **BACKGROUND**

Food and nutrition practitioners in all areas of practice are expected to provide quality services that are measured and evaluated to assure quality outcomes. Quality services are a foundation of the Academy's Code of Ethics, Scope of Practice, Standards of Practice, and Standards of Professional Performance for registered dietitian nutritionists (RDNs) and nutrition and dietetics technicians, registered (NDTRs). Importantly, consumers, third party payers, and regulatory agencies also expect quality, evidence-based nutrition care and services, and have access to data that report quality measures by facility and compares facilities' services to one another. Providing quality food and nutrition services that show measurable outcomes and incorporating them into healthcare standards of care and provider practice settings will also elevate the unique contribution of food and nutrition practitioners.

With the goal of providing an easy-to-access list of resources for Academy members to use, the Quality Strategies Workgroup, under the guidance of the Quality Management Committee, recruited member volunteers through an application process to form the Quality Leader Alliance (QLA). QLA members were asked to contribute the quality-related resources used the most. The following collection of recommended resources is categorized as to their use. The terms are a resource for registered dietitian nutritionists, nutrition and dietetic technicians, registered, and other food and nutrition practitioners, as applicable. As a reference document, the definitions serve as standardized language and standardized application in various practice settings.

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# **APPENDIX**

# Dietetic Internships or Coordinated Programs

The Quality Resource Collection can be used in conjunction with activities or projects to meet various ACEND required core competencies for dietetic interns and students in coordinated dietetics programs. The following competencies align well with the Quality Resource Collection

- CRDN 1.1 Select indicators of program quality and/or customer service and measure achievement of objectives.
- CRDN 1.3 Justify programs, products, services and care using appropriate evidence or data.
- CRDN 1.5 Conduct projects using appropriate research methods, ethical procedures and data analysis.
- CRDN 4.5 Analyze quality, financial and productivity data for use in planning
- CRDN 4.10 Analyze risk in nutrition and dietetics practice.

# Ideas for Projects Related to the Quality Resource Collection

In a community rotation use items in the Quality Resource Collection to

- Create a method to collect data for a community program.
- Analyze data for program outcomes.
- Conduct a quality improvement project for a community program.
- Assess program compliance with federal and state rules and regulations and develop a plan for improvement.
- Review and evaluate the school or district wellness plan. Implement an initiative related to the wellness plan to improve the quality of wellness in the school.
- Identify a problem or opportunity for improvement then use a QI process or tool to initiate change and improve outcomes.

## In a Food Service Management Rotation

- Review food service department layout and facility design, equipment, and flow using flow charts and diagrams, then make recommendations for improving flow.
- Review food service department labor plan. Analyze production needs and other factors that impact labor such as employee status (FT/PT/FTE), scope of services, and hours of operation. Utilize QI processes to evaluate productivity or other outcomes.
- Identify a problem or opportunity for improvement then use a QI process or tool to initiate change and improve outcomes.

#### In a Clinical Rotation

- Use electronic health records and other informatics systems to obtain data and outcomes for nutrition care. Create a plan to improve processes related to outcomes.
- Review current educational materials (handouts, poster, displays, etc.) provided for patients or staff education. Collect data regarding material utilization. Determine potential outcome measures of materials.
- Identify a problem or opportunity for improvement then use a QI process or tool to initiate change and improve outcomes.

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## **Didactic Program in Dietetics**

The quality resource collection can be used in conjunction with assignments related ACEND core knowledge requirements for students in didactic programs in dietetics. The following core knowledge requirement aligns well with the quality resource collection.

KRDN 4.6 Analyze data for assessment and evaluate data to be used in decision-making for continuous quality improvement.

# Assignment Idea

Conduct a personal Quality Improvement Project

- Students identify an area in their personal life that needs improvement (e.g. exercise, study habits, flossing teeth, etc.).
- Students use the principles of the PDSA cycle (plan, do, study, act) to complete the project. Student identifies
  - what he/she **Plans** to change
  - what he/she did to **Do** to carry out the plan
  - what data he/she **Studied** to determine if improvement was made (results could be
    presented using a graph or chart or method found in the quality resource collection)
  - How he/she would **Act** differently to improve their progress further
- Student tracks progress over the course of a semester or for another specified time period, such as 7 weeks.
  - Students present data using a QI tool i.e. histogram, run and control chart, flow chart.
- The QI projects are presented in short 5 min presentations in class or in written documents
