The self-study/site visit fee is based on administrative costs for preparing the review team for the on-site evaluation, processing the self-study report, and preparing reports from ACEND® volunteers, plus the average cost of travel, lodging and per diem for each team member participating in the 1½ day (2½ day for international) on-site program evaluation.
