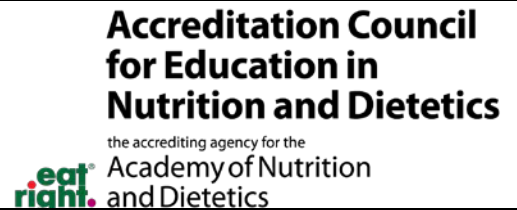


DOMESTIC RDN ACCREDITATION FEE SCHEDULE EFFECTIVE June 2026



DOMESTIC RDN ANNUAL FEE*	DOMESTIC RDN ANNUAL FEE SCHEDULE PER CALENDAR YEAR		
<p>The annual fee applies to all domestic (continental U.S. states and districts, Alaska, Hawaii and Puerto Rico) Registered Dietitian Nutritionist (RDN) programs that hold candidate, full or probationary accreditation. In general, ACEND® invoices programs for the annual fee in September for the upcoming calendar year and the deadline for payment is in December.</p> <p>New programs granted candidate accreditation are assessed a prorated annual fee after accreditation is granted.</p> <p>For consortium/partnership programs, the annual fee covers the program fee for one institution plus a \$300 Web listing fee for the second institution. Both institutions will be listed separately on ACEND's Web site. <p>The self-study/site visit fee is based on administrative costs (\$4,280) for preparing for the on-site evaluation, processing the self-study report, and preparing reports from ACEND® volunteers, plus the average cost of travel, lodging and per diem for each team member participating in the 2½ day on-site program evaluation.</p> <p>If additional reviewers and/or days are needed because of the complexity of the program, such as a DPD with an ISPP or geographic location of supervised practice sites, the fee will be adjusted accordingly.</p> <p>Programs with several consortia/partnership institutions will be assessed cost of travel for one additional reviewer per partner institution.</p>	One program at one site	Jun 2026-May 2029 \$8,260 2 team members

DOMESTIC RDN CANDIDACY FOR ACCREDITATION FEE		DOMESTIC RDN CANDIDACY FEE SCHEDULE	
<p>New programs seeking candidacy for accreditation will be charged a one-time eligibility application fee and a one-time candidacy self-study/site visit fee. The eligibility application fee includes registration for the program director to attend the program director workshop.</p> <p>The self-study/site visit fee is based on administrative costs for preparing the review team for the on-site evaluation, processing the self-study report, and preparing reports from ACEND® volunteers, plus the average cost of travel, lodging and per diem for each team member participating in the 1½ day. ACEND® staff may attend candidacy site visits at no additional cost to the program.</p> <p>Programs in a consortium/partnership will be assessed cost of travel for one additional reviewer per member/partner institution.</p>	Eligibility fee for pre-candidacy	Jun 2026-May 2029 \$3,000

BRIDGE QUALITY APPROVAL			FEE
<p>The ACEND® Bridge Quality-Approval process evaluates Bridge quality indicators, including the curriculum related to select ACEND competencies and performance indicators. The Bridge is not accredited; rather, it is a quality assurance process. Bridges will be re-evaluated every five years.</p> <p>Bridge fees include an annual maintenance fee applied each year to support administrative oversight, maintenance of bridge records, and monitoring ongoing quality. In addition, the Bridge Quality Approval Review fee, assessed every five years, covers the administrative costs associated with the ACEND® Bridge evaluations.</p> <p>Note: fees for late submission of materials/reports and late payment of fees are the same for bridge quality approval as listed above for accredited programs.</p>			<p>Annual Fee \$350</p> <p>Bridge Quality Approval Review \$850</p>

<p>ACEND® does not accredit graduate-level programs in nutrition or dietetics unless they meet accreditation requirements for entry-level preparation. However, advanced-degree listings are often requested by individuals searching for graduate programs for professional development and career advancement.</p> <p>ACEND® can, at its discretion, list graduate programs in nutrition and dietetics-related areas beyond entry-level on the Academy's Web site for an annual fee.</p>			<p>Before Jan 1, 2027 \$300</p> <p>After Jan 1, 2027 \$350</p>
