Thank you for accessing the ACEND Faculty & Preceptor Training PowerPoint. These slides are intended as a **supplement** to the orientation and on-going training that a program provides to faculty and preceptors in order to be in compliance with Required Elements 5.2c and 5.3b of the ACEND 2022 and Future Education Model Accreditation Standards. Programs will still need to provide training on the program's mission, goals and objectives, and strategies to recognize and monitor biases in self and others and reduce instances of microaggressions and discrimination to be fully compliant with Required Elements 5.2 and 5.3.

This presentation was developed as a tool for program directors to use to train their faculty and preceptors on the ACEND Standards. The script (slide notes) is written as narration for the program director to provide this training to their own faculty and preceptors. Here are some ideas about how to use these slides:

1) Provide complete presentation to faculty and preceptors (full or edited version).	Please note that Standard 3 is offered twice within this training – first for the 2022 Standards, followed by information on the Future Education Model (FEM) Standards. Program directors are welcome to remove any slides they feel irrelevant to their program or move the slides around as they see fit such as if you are a program under the 2022 ACEND Accreditation Standards, you may wish to remove the FEM slides for Standard 3.
2) Incorporate slides from this presentation into a custom program orientation/training	Programs have permission to take specific slides from this presentation and incorporate into their own presentations or edit this PowerPoint to include program-specific information.
3) Use this information to inform a custom program orientation/training	Program directors may view this presentation and take what they've learned to add to their own orientation/training, rather than using specific slides from this presentation.
