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The Academy's mission is always in motion.

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Each fiscal quarter, the Academy will highlight key achievements and milestones.

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Beginning in 2028, the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services will require hospitals to report the Academy-led Malnutrition Care Score, making it the first nutrition focused electronic clinical quality measure in CMS's Hospital Inpatient Quality Reporting Program and recognizing nutrition and dietetics as a measurable evidence-based component of healthcare.

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The Academy's latest Nutrition Fact Check explores low- and no-calorie sweeteners, providing practitioners and the public with current evidence-based research.

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In an op-ed published in RealClearPolicy, Academy President Tammy Randall highlighted nutrition's essential role in preventing and managing chronic diseases across healthcare, reinforcing the importance of positioning nutrition and dietetics professionals as valued contributors in improving health outcomes.

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The Academy's new telehealth resource helps RDNs navigate licensure, regulations, contracting, billing, and professional responsibility when delivering nutrition care virtually.

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The Academy and Feeding America announced a national partnership to advance Food as Medicine and expand access to nutrition interventions for people facing food and nutrition insecurity.

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DPGs and MIGs now have dedicated pages on eatrightPRO.org, making it easier than ever to connect with peers and join communities that support your professional goals while advancing the Academy's strategic plan through operational excellence.

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We strengthened our spokesperson program by adding six new spokespeople, helping us generate over 3,000 media pickups and deliver credible evidence-based nutrition information to the public.
