Dietetics Application Process for ACEND® Supervised Practice Programs Update

ACEND's Annual Review of Pass Rate

Annually in February, ACEND receives pass rate data from the Commission on Dietetic Registration (CDR). During its April Board meeting, the ACEND Board will review programs with three-year pass rate averages (2022-2024) on the CDR examination that are below the ACEND benchmark. Should your program's pass rate fall below the ACEND benchmark for the three-year pass rate average (2022-2024), as part of ACEND's annual monitoring process, the program may receive pass rate letter after the April ACEND Board meeting. However, keep in mind that ACEND understands the recent national decline in the CDR exam pass rate which has been significant and may be due to factors outside the program's control. As such, the ACEND Board continues to take a holistic approach when reviewing pass rate while monitoring programs to ensure success of our program graduates. ACEND Policy and Procedure Manual Revised March 2025

The **ACEND Policy and Procedure Manual** has been updated and posted to the ACEND website. The recent changes to ACEND policies are designed to ensure a fair and student-centered dietetics application process that also supports the needs of programs.

These recent updates include:

- Updates to the Ethics, Confidentiality and Conflict of Interest policy related to complying with the dietetics application process traffic rules, and requirement for participation in the Dietetics Inclusive Centralized Application System (DICAS) (Policy 1.6.M).

ACEND Manuscript: Development of the Advanced Practice Doctoral (APD) Standards

Important Site Visit Policy Changes

The following policies go into effect this fall and are applicable to all programs that have site visits scheduled planned for July-December 2025.

Hotel Booking:

Program Reviewers will now be responsible for booking their own lodging based on the program's suggestions. ACEND has developed a form that is included with the Site Visit Scheduled Letter sent to programs once the site visit has been scheduled. The program should provide two to three hotel recommendations that meet the requirements provided on the form. If the program would prefer to book the hotel on behalf of the review team, you can indicate this on the form. We are also asking that the program provide affordable restaurant recommendations for both breakfast and dinner. The program will be responsible for submitting this form to the members of the review team and ACEND manager assigned to the site visit as soon as possible and no later than the due date of the self-study report which is 12-weeks prior to the scheduled site visit.

Food and Beverages During the Site Visit:

Programs must provide a modest lunch as well as small snacks and beverages while on site as a courtesy to the program reviewers. The program director must contact the review team directly for allergies and meal preferences. This information will be noted in the Site Visit Scheduled Letter as well.

Updated Guidance Information for the 2022 and Future Education Model Accreditation Standards Released

As part of the annual review process, ACEND updates materials based on feedback to improve interpretation and compliance with the standards. The Guidance Information Document for the 2022 and Future Education Model Accreditation Standards has been updated to provide clarification for several Required Elements. A list of the updates can be found on pages 4-5 of the document.

2026 Annual Fee for Program Budgets

As many ACEND-accredited programs start planning future budgets, this is a reminder that the 2026 Annual Accreditation Fee can be found on the **Accreditation Fee Schedule**, in the Policies and Procedures section of the **ACEND website**. Annual fee invoices are typically prepared in September and due mid-December of the previous year; therefore, the 2026 Annual Accreditation Fee will be due in December 2025.

Program directors will receive an email from ACEND when annual fee invoices are ready in September 2025. There are two ways to access a program's open invoice:

- Log in into the **ACEND Portal** and click the "Pay Open Invoices" QuickPay link, under "Actions"
- Save the QuickPay Link separately and access it at any time without having to log into the ACEND portal. ACEND recommends sending this link to the person who pays program bills for future reference as the QuickPay Link will not change.

Dietetics Application Process 2025-2026 Cycle Resources Now Available

The Dietetics Application Process (DAP) Task Force has updated resources related to the Dietetics Application Process for the 2025-2026 cycle. These documents include minor revisions to the DAP Timeline and Dates document, Traffic Rules, DAP General Guidance Document, Admission Communication Samples and Applicant Information Handout.

Please note that the key dates will remain the same for the 2025-2026 cycle. **As a reminder, starting with the 2025-2026 application cycle, ALL Supervised Practice Programs MUST participate in DICAS.** This requirement does not apply to enrolled students selected within the same institution.

July 8, 2025 ACEND Town Hall – Putting Competency Software into Practice

ACEND® will be hosting a topic-specific town hall on **Tuesday, July 8, 2025 from 11:00 AM – 12:00 PM (Central Time)** regarding the application of Competency software by an ACEND-accredited program. Darla O'Dwyer, PhD, RD is the Dietetic Internship (DI) Program Director from Stephen F. Austin State University in Nacogdoches, Texas. Over the last year, she has been implementing Competency within the DI program and will be sharing the program's experience with the

software, including data organization, examples of rubrics and checklists, and student and preceptor feedback. All ACEND program directors and faculty interested in working with Competency are encouraged and welcome to participate. The webinar will be recorded and there are no CPEUs offered for this event.

ACEND Accredited Directory and Portal Updates

Based on feedback from our program directors and students, we are excited to share with you some recent changes made to the ACEND Accredited Program Directory and Portal.

Several changes were made to the Accredited Programs directory so that the directory continues to serve as a valuable resource for prospective students and our programs. The following changes were made for prospective students to find programs on our Accredited Program Directory to better fit their needs:

- **Admission Requirements (DI, GP):** Prospective students can now filter whether a supervised practice program requires a DPD Verification Statement. This will be helpful for our programs as many second-career students, international students, and non-DPD students inquire about how to enroll in a supervised practice/experiential learning site.
- **Education Format (All Programs):** We have created a new “Education Format” filter section for prospective students to search for programs based on the education format offered by the program, such as finding a program that offers fully online courses vs. fully in-person coursework.
- **Tuition (All Programs):** We will now provide a link to the program’s tuition information page under the program details. You will be able to provide this link to ACEND in the 2025 Annual Report.

Two changes were made to the ACEND Portal:

- **Site Visit Team Details (All Programs):** Previously, program directors could only view their site visit team details when approving the site visit team and site visit date. Now, program directors can see the site visit review team details any time after the site visit team has been approved.
- **Access to Competency Software Login and Trainings:** We have added a link to the login page for the Competency Software to the program director dashboard, as well as a link to the new Competency Software training page. For more details, see the article below.

Competency Software Training Resources Now on the ACEND Portal

ACEND has created training materials for program directors using the ACEND-provided Competency Software for competency assessment. This month, ACEND has moved these training videos and user guides for program directors, preceptors/faculty, and students to the ACEND Portal, along with documentation for Learning Management System (LMS) integration for Canvas, Blackboard, D2L, Bright Space, and Typhon.

To access the trainings, log into the **ACEND Portal**, scroll down to the new “Competency Software” section on the dashboard and click on the link “Access Competency Software Trainings and Resources”. In addition to the training links for program directors, ACEND has complied the student and preceptor/faculty trainings into PDFs to share with individuals using the software. These PDFs may also be integrated within your student or preceptor handbook for ease of access.

The ACEND Policy and Procedure Manual has been updated and posted to the ACEND website. The latest changes to ACEND policies approved by the ACEND Board include:

- Terminology updates to the Program Reviewer and Ethics, Confidentiality and Conflict of Interest policy (Policy 1.5 and 1.6)
- Clarifications made to Requests for Reconsideration of ACEND Board Decisions policy (Policy 2.8) and Appeals and Arbitration of Adverse
- Accreditation Decisions (Policy 2.9)
- Updates to Complaints About Programs and Complaints About ACEND policies to clarify the steps a complainant may take should assistance be required
- (Policy 2.10 and 2.11)
- Updates to the Program Closure Policy to note the procedure in the unlikely event a program that ACEND accredits closes without a teach-out

NEW Resource Available – Program Completion Calculation Spreadsheet and Tutorials

ACEND is happy to share a new resource created to help our programs more accurately collect and calculate data for the ACEND-required program completion objective. During ACEND's review of Program Evaluation Plans (PEP), it was identified that there may be some confusion from programs on how to collect and report this data.

To support programs, ACEND created an optional spreadsheet specific to the program completion objective. This optional template should allow programs to capture their program completion data more accurately.

In this template programs can input the number of students that enter a program and complete it at 100% and at 150% of program length. The spreadsheet will allow programs to keep track of those students who withdraw or are terminated.

Instructions are located on the first tab of the spreadsheet. An additional tab was included for programs that have more than one program length to support their different program options.

At first glance, the spreadsheet may seem complicated; however, completing it will be simple. ACEND created several short video tutorials guiding you on how to complete the spreadsheet and how to incorporate the data from the spreadsheet into the Program Evaluation Plan and the annual report. We believe this will be extremely helpful to you and to your program, so please take the time to review the videos and make use of the template.

Earn Continuing Education Credits for Writing Your Self-Study Report!

Did you know that your hard work in writing the self-study report and completing the program review process can count toward your continuing education? Under **Activity Type 191 – Expert Work**, ACEND Program Directors can earn 15 CPEUs for RDNs and 10 CPEUs for NDTRs per five-year cycle for participating in dietetics-related activities that showcase your expertise, including the site visit process. You decide how many CPEUs your self-study and site visit work is worth based on the time and effort you have invested. This is a great opportunity to get recognized for the valuable work you are already doing. Just be sure to complete and retain the Expert Work Attestation Form available on the [CDR website](#).

ACEND Standards Revisions Effective November 1, 2025

In response to recent federal directives related to diversity, equity, and inclusion (DEI) in higher education, as well as guidance from legal counsel, ACEND revised the DEI-related requirements across all its accreditation standards. The draft revised standards were released for public comment from July 28, 2025-September 29, 2025. ACEND would like to thank those who took the time to share their feedback during this period. Following a review of the public comments, the ACEND Board voted at its October 2025 meeting to approve the revisions. The updated standards are now available on the ACEND webpages below and are effective November 1, 2025.

ACEND Proposed 2027 Accreditation Standards – Call for Comments

The Accreditation Council for Education in Nutrition and Dietetics has released the proposed 2027 Accreditation Standards for Nutrition and Dietetics Coordinated Programs (CP), Didactic Programs (DPD), Internship Programs (DI), and Associate Programs with the Dietetic Technician Option (DT). The draft 2027 Standards are the result of a planned five-year review cycle of the 2022 Accreditation Standards to ensure compliance with the Department of Education regulation. Copies of the draft Standards documents and the surveys to provide feedback may be found at [Proposed 2027 Standards](#). Note that there are four surveys to provide feedback: one (1) for the 2027 Standards and Required Elements and three (3) related to the Competencies and Performance Indicators for CPs/DIs, DPDs, and Associate Programs with the DT option. The surveys allow you to share any comments or concerns you have about the proposed 2027 Standards.

ACEND is offering two webinars on December 16 and 18, 2025, at 11:00 AM-12:30 PM CT to describe the recommended and proposed changes and their rationale. The links to register for the webinars and the recording will also be posted on the [Town Hall webpage](#).

Dietetic Application Process – Violations Submission Process

ACEND® has established a process for reviewing violations submitted against ACEND-accredited supervised practice programs (CP, GP, DI) in order to ensure compliance with the [**Dietetics Applicant and Program Traffic Rules**](#). These traffic rules represent the guidelines under which the nutrition and dietetics supervised practice programs and their institutions will conduct the annual admissions process.
